New Business:

1. Review of Proposed Budget F. Y. 2025-2026

Dan Armbruster had Clerk/Treasurer Phyllis Baranski review the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2026-2027. Phyllis Baranski stated the millages that support the proposed budget are as follows:

General Operating- 12.50 mills

Streets- 5.00 mills

Ambulance- .50 mills

Cemetery- .10 mills

Grand Total- 18.10 mills

Phyllis Baranski read the proposed Capital Outlay Projects by fund, as well as the proposed revenue and expense totals for each fund. Council members discussed the Capital Outlay projects, as needed, as well as additional revenues not reflected in the proposed budget, such as selling of a police car and donations from the DDA to park projects.

Public Comment: Sandy Fritz, Elkton Community Club, questioned the removal of the tennis court area and how that would affect the Elkton Autumnfest entertainment tent location.

Motion Matt Lewis, second Shane Schember to adjourn the Public Hearing.
